Stanley Kukachka, 87

Stanley Joseph Kukachka, 87, of New Hope, formerly of Montgomery, died Saturday, Jan. 12, 2008 at North Memorial Hospice in Robbinsdale.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, Jan. 17, at 11:30 a.m. at Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church in Montgomery, with Rev. Cory Rohlfing officiating. Military rites will be conducted by the Montgomery Area Veterans Honor Guard.

Interment will be at Fort Snelling National Cemetery in Minneapolis on Friday, Jan. 18 at 11 a.m. Visitation will be held from 9 to 11 a.m. Thursday at the Keohen Memorial Funeral Home in Montgomery.

Born August 24, 1920, in Montgomery, Stan was a son of Frank and Anna Sophie (Morovec) Kukachka. He attended St. Raphael Catholic School, Sherman High School and graduated from the University of Minnesota. He also attended the Dunwoody Institute in Minneapolis. Stan was a veteran of WWII, serving with the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1945. On February 9, 1946, he married Millie E. Turek at Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church in Montgomery. They lived in Bloomington and he was a purchasing agent for Stark Electronics in Minneapolis from 1961 to 1982, when he retired. They moved back to Montgomery in 1986. He was a member of the VFW and American Legion posts.
